Event organisers have, at all times, a primary duty of care to ensure the safety of staff, contractors, volunteers and persons affected by the event site and are responsible for the provision and maintenance of a safety plan Remember that as the event organizer you must consult and coordinate with all ...

### **Safety Huddles**

Post-Event Safety Huddles Post-event huddles take place as soon as possible after a safety incident (eg a patient fall, medication event, wrong procedure, equipment failure, escalating patient/family concern) or near miss is detected Organizations should define the timeframe within which post-event safety huddles should happen for
